Letter of Ministry of Education under Tai-Jiao-Go (2) Zi No. 1100120148 on September 8, 2021

- Article 1 In order to process applications for cross-university major study from students of the University System of Taiwan (National Central University, National Cheng Chi University, National Tsing Hua University and National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University, hereinafter referred to as the four schools), the Regulations are enacted in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations of Ministry of Education and the four schools' academic regulations.
- Article 2 In order to develop students' learning, expand the fields of learning, promote inter-school collaboration, and make good use of the four schools' shared teaching resources and equipment, the four schools allow students in their bachelor programs to apply for cross-university double major study within the System.
- Applications shall be subject to approval of both the students' school and the school with which they apply for double major study.
- The applications referred to in the preceding paragraph are only applicable to the choices of a dissimilar department at another school as the second major. The nature thereof shall be determined by the student's school and the school with which they apply for the double major study.
- Article 3 Students who apply for cross-university double major study shall follow the relevant regulations of the department of the school with which they apply for double major study governing application qualifications, requested study years, subjects and credits.
- Article 4 Students who apply for cross-university double major study shall follow the relevant regulations of their schools governing student status, the calculation formula for academic performance, restrictions on total credits, response to the credits of failed subjects meeting the expulsion criteria and applications for an extension of study years
- Article 5 Students undertaking cross-university double major study shall complete the credits of subjects required by their major departments, and also the total required professional (specialized) subjects of the bachelor programs, and credits, required by their double major departments.
- Article 6 The curriculum and apportioning of tuition fees for students undertaking cross-

university double major study shall be handled in accordance with the inter-school minor study agreement between the four schools within the System.

Article 7 For students undertaking cross-university double major study, the names of the double major study school, department and degree will be included on the diploma awarded by the school after they are held satisfying the graduation requirements defined by their major departments and double major departments, upon confirmation of their school and the school with which they apply for double major study.

Article 8 If it is impossible for students who apply for cross-university double major study to continue double major study, they shall file an application for waiver of double major study pursuant to the relevant requirements of the school with which they applied for double major study. This application will be submitted to the offices of academic affairs of both schools for future reference, upon approval of the chairs of both major and double major departments.

Notwithstanding, if the additional subjects and credits which they have completed meet a minor department's requirements, they shall be held qualified for the minor department.

Otherwise, whether the credits of double major study subjects they have completed may be included in the graduation credits of their major department shall be determined subject to the relevant requirements of their major department.

Article 9 Any matters not covered herein are subject to the academic regulations of the student's school and double major department.

Article 10 The Regulations shall be enforced upon resolution of the Meeting of the Dean of Academic Affairs and Meeting of the President of the UST and approval of the four schools' faculty meetings, and reported to the Ministry of Education for future reference. The same shall apply where the Regulations are amended.
